November 24th: We all know Thanksgiving is a time for family, food and gratitude. It's also a good time to check the batteries in your smoke detectors! Did you know deep fried turkey fires top the list of calls answered by 911 dispatch? Pro tip: Carry out from Cracker Barrel ;) Just kidding, I love to cook for the holidays and here is one of my favorite recipes for "upping" your game with Brussel sprouts. They are one of my favorite veggies and when they are combined with sweet potatoes and bacon, you literally cannot go wrong. You will need sprouts, sweet potatoes, thick bacon, balsamic vinegar, red pepper flakes & cracked black pepper. I'm not listing measurements as it is dependent on how many you are cooking for. Heat oven to 400 F. Slice off the ends of the sprouts, peel away one layer of leaves and slice in half. Put them in a large bowl. Peel the potatoes and chop into 1-inch pieces. Add to bowl of sprouts. Slice the bacon into 1/4 inch pieces and add to bowl. Lightly pour olive oil, balsamic vinegar, red pepper flakes and cracked black pepper in the bowl and lightly toss together. Spread mixture on a large sheet pan and bake for 40 minutes. Ênjoy!
